





We visited the famous Charles Bridge. It was erected in the 14th century on the site of the old wooden bridge, the Charles Bridge is one of the main attractions of Prague and the Czech Republic. On the bridge there are 30 copies of the baroque sculptures. The most famous sculpture is St. John of Nepomuk, which by order of the king was thrown from the Charles Bridge. Walking over the bridge crowds of tourists we also could see artists selling their paintings and painted portraits and caricatures. It is better to visite the Charles Bridge at night or early in the morning when there are not so many people. Our group also walked around the Old Town Square. This is not only a symbol of Prague, and the Czech Republic. The exact date

In total there were about 60,000 students, while the city's population stands at around 100,000.
